## Introduction

---

ACTi NVR 3 Server can be accessed in several different ways:

FULL CLIENT (all the client features available):

1. Workstation Application for Windows (supports full functionality)
2. **Microsoft Edge browser client in IE mode** (supports full functionality)

LITE CLIENT:

3. Microsoft Edge, Chrome, Safari, Firefox in the normal mode (most frequently used features only)

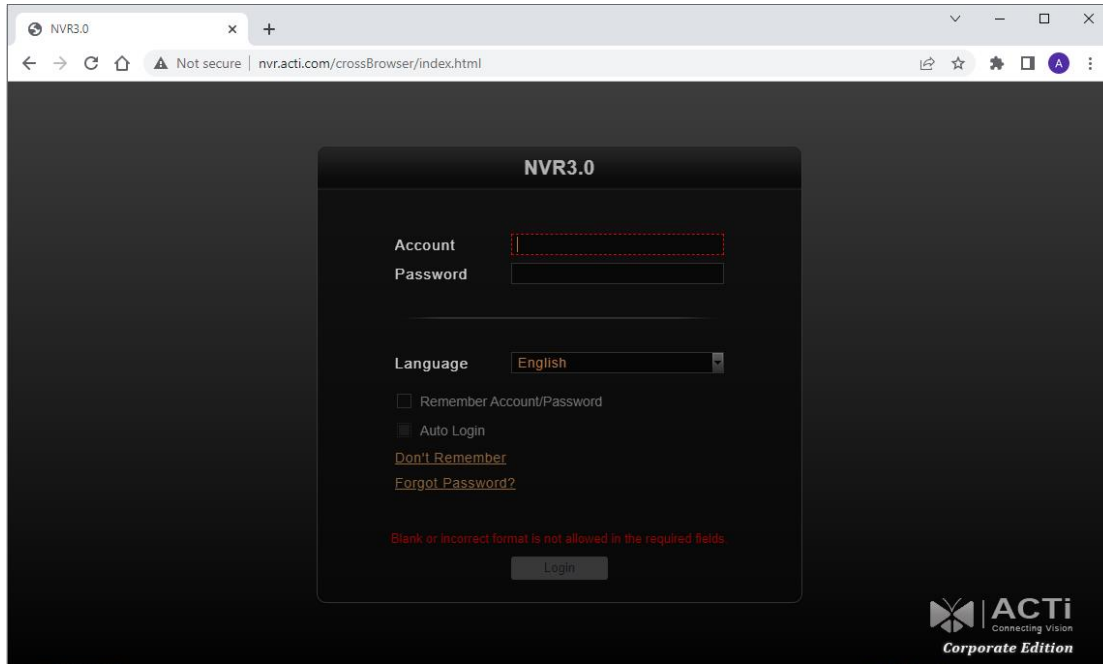
MOBILE CLIENT:

4. ACTi Mobile Client for iOS
5. ACTi Mobile Client for Android

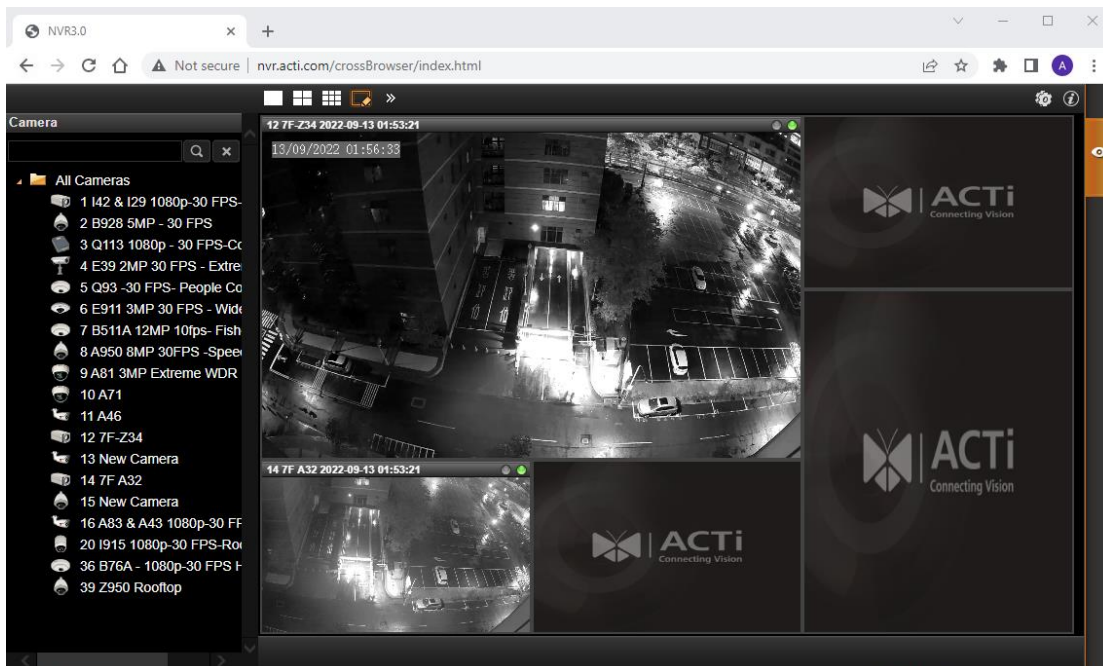
## Lite Web Client

When you access the NVR server by using Edge, Chrome, Firefox or Safari browser, then by default you will be accessing the LITE WEB CLIENT interface. It contains less features, but it is very easy to use.

Example: Using **Chrome** to access NVR 3.



The server will redirect the URL to /crossBrowser/ which means loading the Lite Web Client. Upon login, you will enjoy the simplified view: Live view layouts up to 16 channels, embedded playback, no setup.

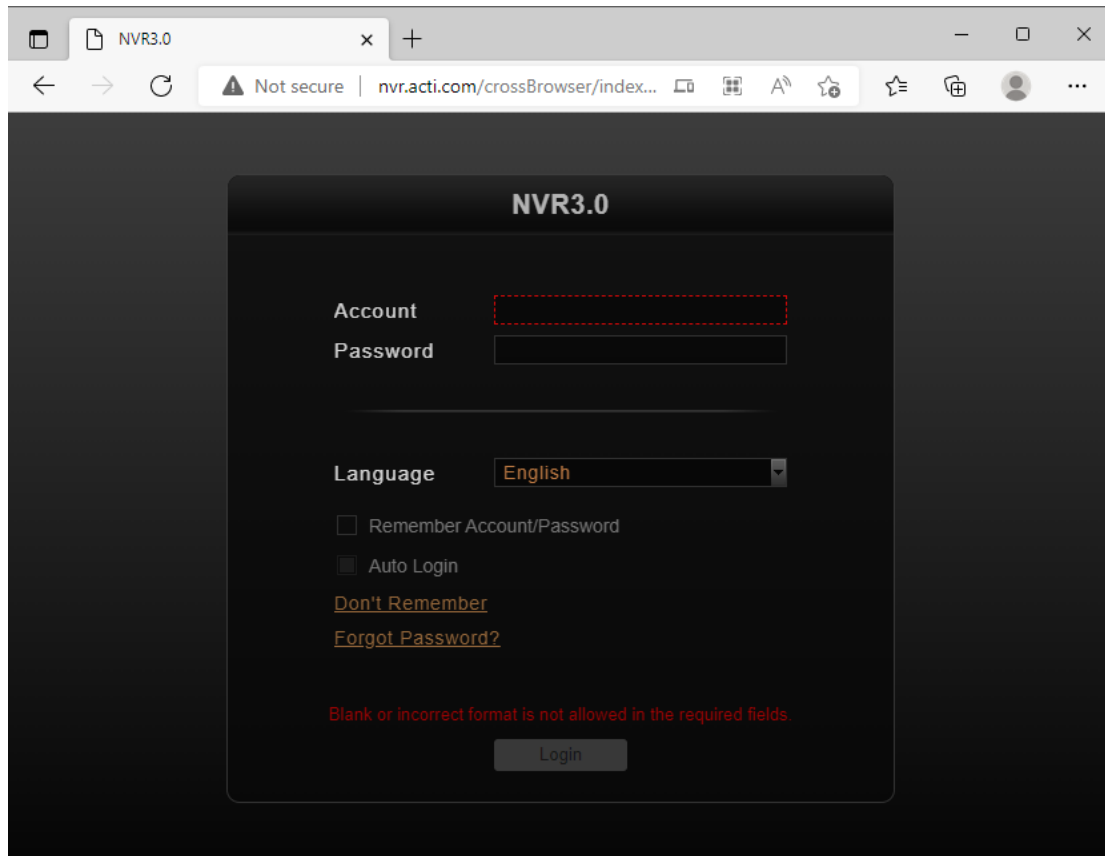


## Full Web Client

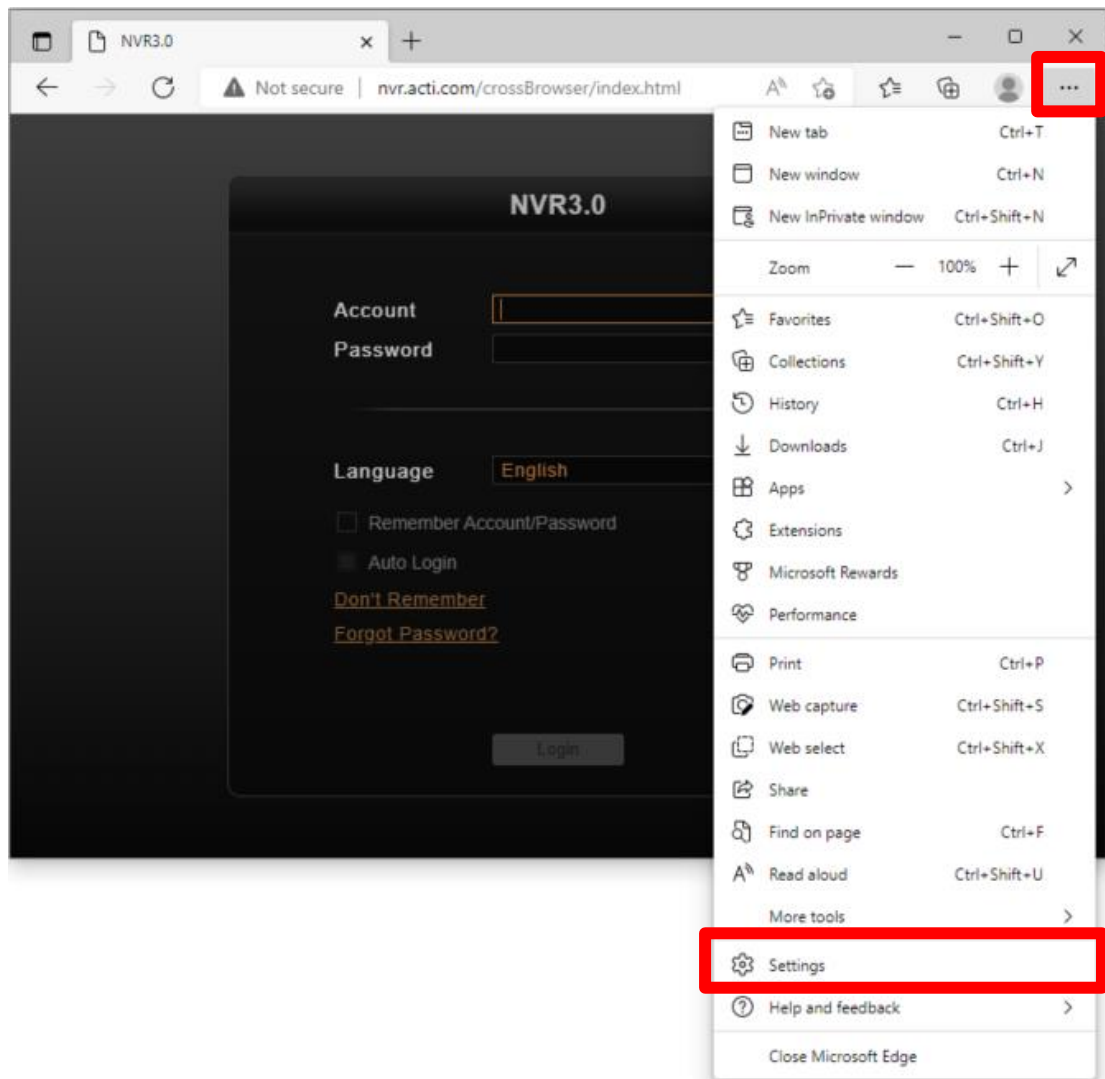
If you want to enjoy the full set of features of the NVR 3, you can do it by using **Microsoft Edge browser in IE Mode**. It only takes a few moments to set up the IE mode on the Edge browser.

Before making any changes, the Microsoft Edge also loads the Lite Web Client:



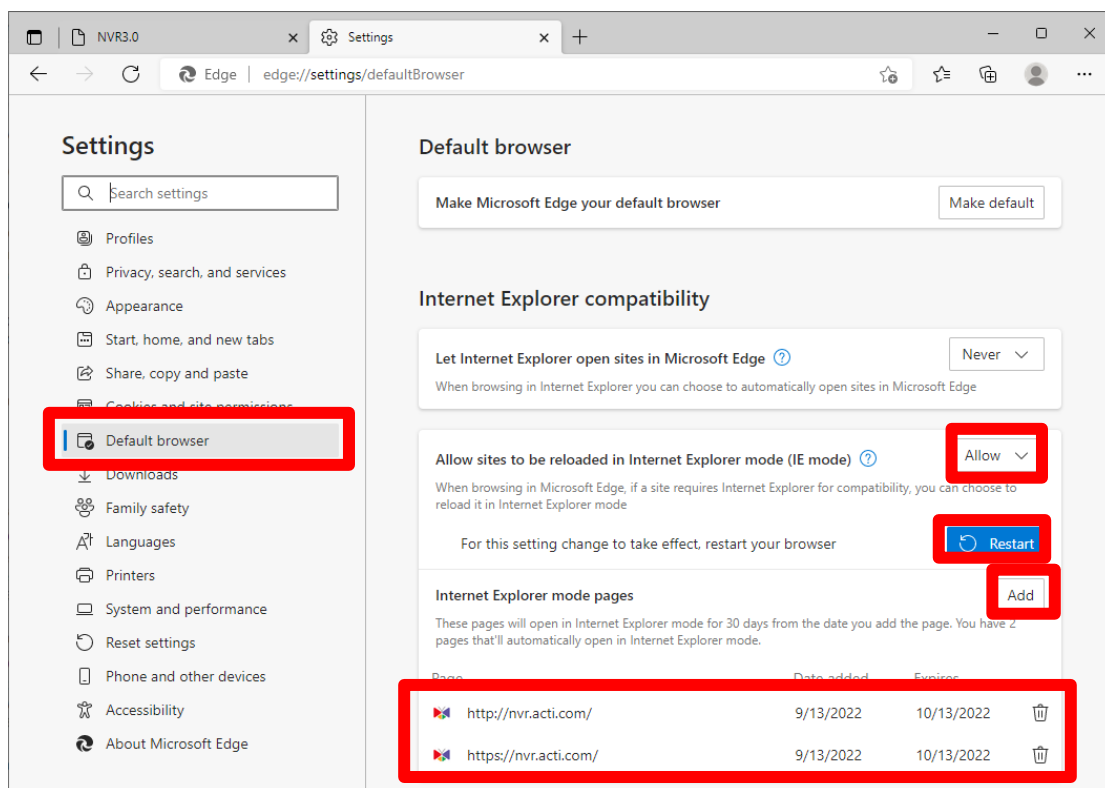
To enable the Full Web Client, do the following steps:

1. Click on the “...” button.
2. Go to Settings.



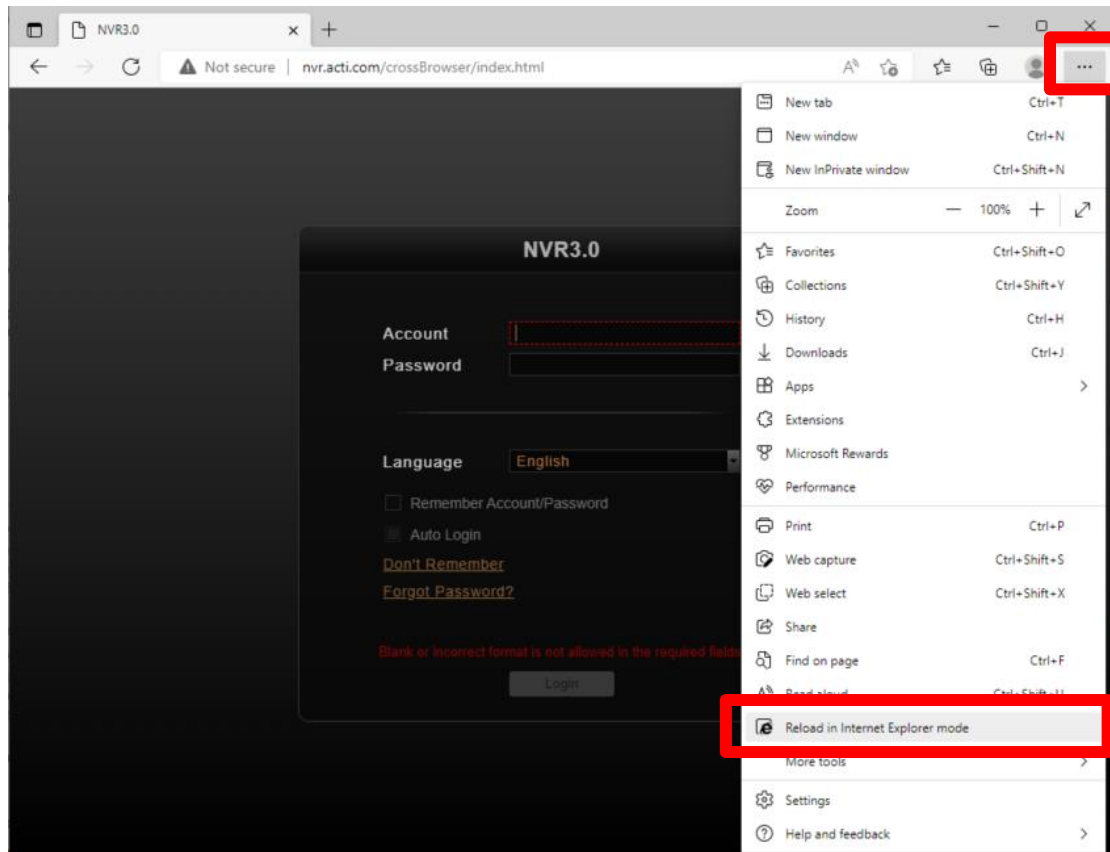
Configure the browser to support IE mode:

1. Click on the menu item named “Default browser”.
2. Set ALLOW for “Allow sites to be reloaded in Internet Explorer mode (IR mode)”.
3. Press ADD to add your server’s address with both https and http, in our example we add them as:
  - a. https://nvr.acti.com
  - b. http://nvr.acti.com
4. Press the RESTART button.
5. After the browser’s restart, close the Settings tab.

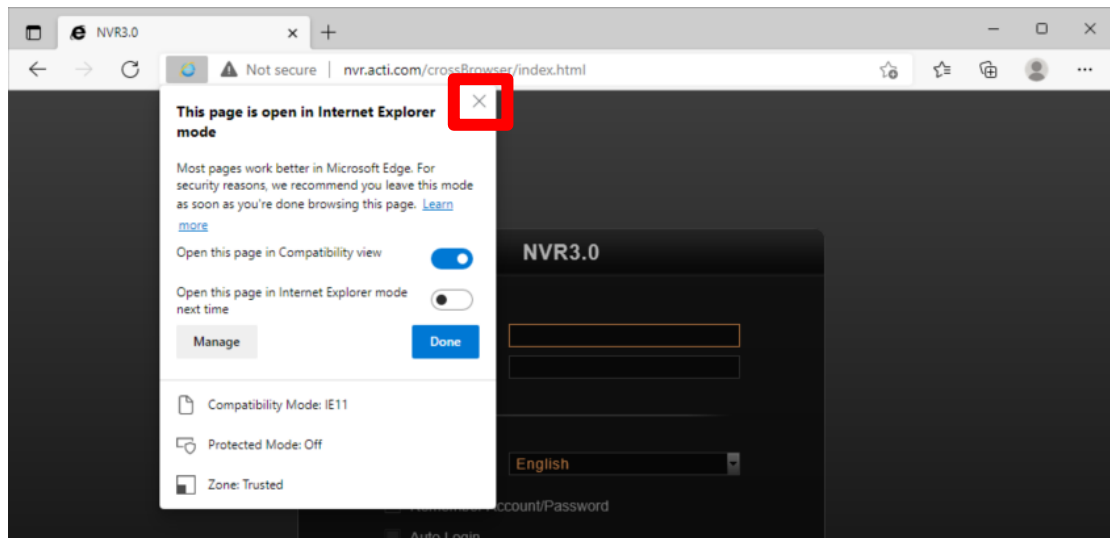


Now activate the IE mode:

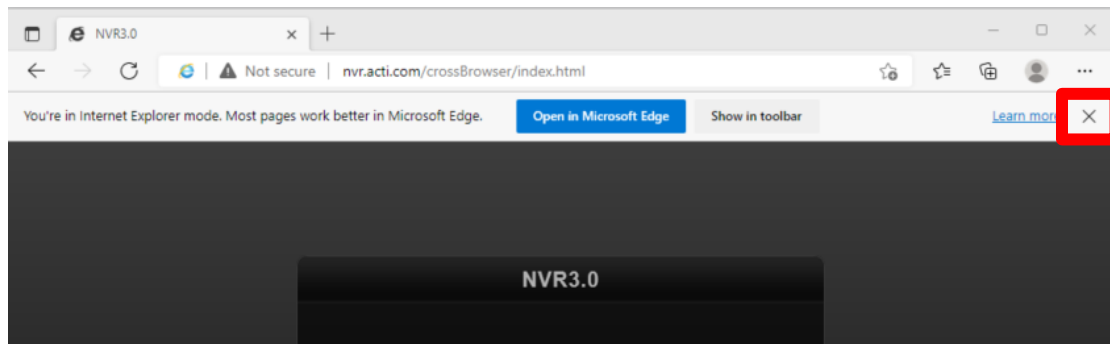
1. Click on the “...” button.
2. Select “Reload in Internet Explorer mode”



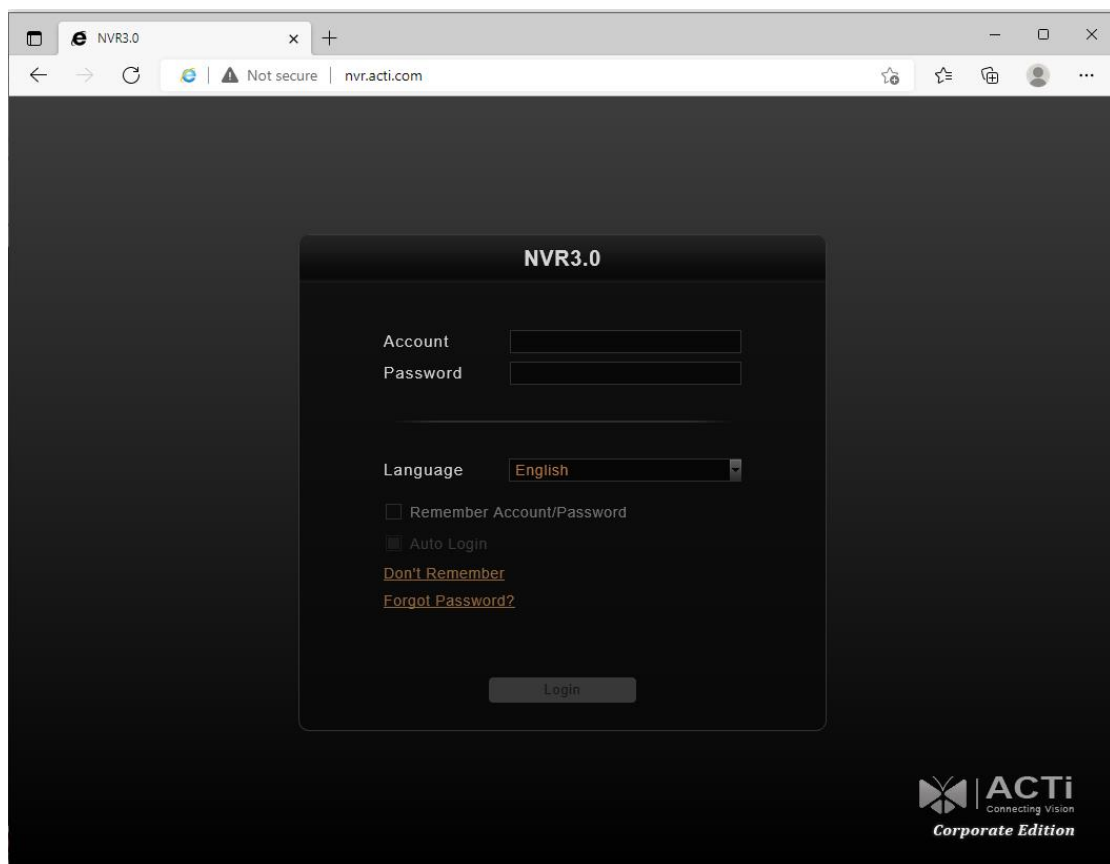
Close that reminder window from "X" because it is referring to the crossbrowser page which we do not need later.



Also close the reminder that suggests to go back to the Microsoft Edge mode.



Now all is done, simply re-type the correct server address to the browser again, and it will no longer be redirected to the Lite version. In our case, we retype “nvr.acti.com” to the address bar:



The result should be:

1. You see the IE icon in front of the address bar.
2. The URL does not redirect anymore.

You are now using the FULL WEB CLIENT that has all the features available, including setup, full layouts and all:
